The Second Vatican Council teaches:

The Hierarchy - The Appointment of the Twelve.

19. Christ chose twelve apostles and gave them the mission of preaching God's kingdom.

He formed them into a sort of 'college', a permanent group. He made them sharers of His power and sent them out to make all men His disciples, to make men holy, to govern them. Thus they were to spread His Church, to serve it under God's guidance, to govern it to the end of the world.

This mission was confirmed at Pentecost as Christ had promised it would when the Holy Spirit came down on the apostles. Then they preached the Gospel everywhere; and their hearers, inspired by the Spirit, accepted the Gospel.

Thus they began to gather the Church, the Church established by Christ on the apostles, the Church built upon Peter, the Church of which Christ is the Cornerstone.
