The Second Vatican Council teaches:

The Hierarchy - *The Bishops, successors of the Apostles.*

19. That mission entrusted to the apostles will last until the end of the world, for the Gospel they are to preach will always be the Church's life-spring.

The Apostles therefore, as rulers of the Church, took care to appoint men to succeed them, to carry on and complete what they had begun.

And they ordered these men to appoint others to succeed *them*. From the earliest days of the Church the first place has always been accorded to the bishops because of the life-giving contact between them and the original Apostles, because of the unbroken succession that links them.

Thus the teaching of the original Apostles has been given to the world, has been kept safe by the men who succeeded them and by their successors right up to our own day.
