### The Second Vatican Council teaches:

**The Hierarchy** - *The Bishops, successors of the Apostles.*

**20.** Bishops, assisted by priests and deacons, have undertaken to serve the people of God. They preside in God's stead over the Church, they are its teachers. They lead them in worship of God, they govern it. Just as the office given to Peter individually was a permanent office, an office to be handed on, so the collective office of the Apostles - that of caring for the Church - is also a permanent office, an office to be handed on.

The Vatican Council teaches that the bishops have succeeded to the Apostles by God's institution; that men who hear the bishops hear Christ, that men who reject the bishops reject Christ and God, Who sent Christ.
