The Second Vatican Council teaches -

The Hierarchy - *Sacramental character of the episcopate. (cont.)*

21. The bishops are pastors, chosen to care for the flock, servants of Christ, stewards of God's mysteries. They give authentic witness to the Gospel of God's grace and the glorious rule of the Spirit.

At Pentecost Christ enriched the Apostles with a special gift of the Spirit to enable them to fulfil such tremendous duties. The Apostles passed on this same gift to their helpers by laying hands upon them. And the Vatican Council teaches that this same special gift is conferred by the consecration of bishops. It is the fullness of the Sacrament of Orders, the peak of the Sacred Ministry. The consecration of bishops carries with it the charge of sanctifying men, of teaching, of governing, but this office can only be exercised in proper communion with the Pope and the rest of the College of Bishops.
