The Second Vatican Council teaches -

The Hierarchy - *Sacramental character of the episcopate. (cont.)*

21. In both Eastern and Western Churches traditions shows that by the imposition of hands, by the words of consecration, the gifts of the Spirit are given to the bishops, the sacred seal marked on them so that they visibly sustain Christ's role of teacher, shepherd and high priest, that they act in His Person. It is the right of bishops to admit newly-elected members into their ranks by means of the Sacrament of Orders.

The Hierarchy - *The Episcopal College and its Head.*

22. Just as Peter and the Apostles form one college, in the same way the Pope, who succeeds Peter, and the bishops, who succeed the Apostles, are united to one another.

The fact that the bishops are a college can be seen from ancient times, for bishops all over the known world were united with the Bishop of Rome and with each other in bonds of love and peace.

When there was need for discussion the bishops assembled in Councils to settle questions of major importance. The fact that bishops are a college is also shown by the ancient practice of summoning several bishops to take part in a bishop's consecration.
