The Second Vatican Council teaches -

The Hierarchy - The Episcopal College and its Head.

22. (concluded) The College of Bishops has no authority, unless the Pope is at its Head. The Pope as Vicar of Christ has full, supreme and universal power and is always free to use it. The College of Bishops also has full, supreme and universal power, but only with the Pope at its head, and never without him. It was Peter alone whom Christ placed as rock, made bearer of the keys, made shepherd of the whole flock; but the power of binding and loosing was given not only to Peter but to the body of Apostles joined to him.

The College of Bishops expresses the variety and world-wide nature of the people of God. At the same time it expresses the unity of Christ's Church. In the College of Bishops members, while recognising the Pope's Primacy, use their own authority for the good of their people and of the whole Church, which is continually strengthened by the influence of the Holy Spirit.

It is in an ecumenical Council - that is, a Council convened and ratified by the Pope - that the supreme power of the College of Bishops is used. They can also use their power as a college, with the Pope, when scattered all over the world, so long as their joint action has been called for, or approved, by the Pope.
