The Second Vatican Council teaches -

The Hierarchy - *The Mutual Relations of Bishops.*

23. (1) As Peter's successor, the Pope is the permanent, visible principle, the basis of unity for the bishops and all the people. The individual bishops are the visible principle, the basis of unity in their own particular Churches. Therefore each individual bishop represents his own Church but all the bishops together and with the Pope represent the entire Church in a bond of peace, love and unity.

Each bishop governs the particular part of the people of God entrusted to him, and that part only. But as a member of the College of Bishops his concern is for the whole Church. This is a Christ-given duty. Though a bishop does not express his care for other Churches by direct rule, yet his concern makes a valuable contribution to the whole Church. It is the duty of bishops to guard the unity of Faith which is held by all the Church, to teach their people, to love the whole body of Christ, especially the poor and sorrowing, to pray for the persecuted and to promote every activity of interest to the whole Church, anything which spreads the Faith, and brings the light of full Truth to men. By governing their own Churches well, the bishops increase the holiness of the whole body of Christ.
