In his recent pastoral letter Bishop Peter referred to the ongoing pastoral consultation and indicated "much more concrete engagement with the realities that have been highlighted". THAT'S US! The 30 responses submitted to the questions posed by the Bishop Peter are rich in wisdom and insight.

The next step for our parish community is to ensure that what we submit to the diocese reflects this. The initial response document will be presented for discussion and improvement at the OPEN MEETING to be held at OLSE this coming Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> January at 10.30am (refreshments from 10am). Please come to this - especially if you submitted a response to the questions; and especially if you didn't get the chance to do that; what we produce together has fundamental implications for our future as a community.

YEAR OF JUBILEE 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE  
FROM POPE FRANCIS - SOME WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

"Christian hope is not a 'happy ending' which we passively await, but rather, a promise, the Lord's promise, to be welcomed here and now in our world of suffering and sighs."

"[The Jubilee] is a summons not to tarry, to be kept back by our old habits, or to wallow in mediocrity or laziness"

\*We are called to find our greater hope in Him, and then, without delay, carry that hope with us, as pilgrims of light amid the darkness of this world."

[May this Jubilee] "strengthen us in our faith, helping us to recognize the Risen Christ in the midst of our lives, transforming us into pilgrims of Christian hope."

And Bishop Peter writes: "The Holy Father calls us to be 'Pilgrims of Hope' in the midst of the world; calls us to a fresh and genuine encounter with the Lord Jesus, who is the 'door' of our salvation (Jn.10:7.9). The hope we speak of is no mere optimism, it is the serene gift that confronts and conquers all pessimism and cynicism. The hope we speak of fosters that patience which addresses the frenetic haste of a world that has lost its way.
