FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Already in 300 AD, the Eastern Church celebrated the Epiphany and the Baptism of Jesus on 6 January. In the Western Church, this feast was mentioned in the Liturgy of the Hours. With the reform of the liturgy in 1969, the date for this Feast was set on the Sunday after the Epiphany. The Christmas Season concludes with the celebration of this Feast, even though a "window" is left open until 2 February, Candlemas ("light for the gentiles"), the day on which the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple is celebrated.
