#### JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: FORGIVENESS

The second of the six Jubilee themes that we will look at, during this month of March, is <u>Forgiveness</u>. This theme is especially appropriate during this season of Lent. Implicit in the concept of jubilee is the idea of return or restoration. At the heart of forgiveness is the return or restoration not of land or possessions but of relationship. Jesus talked about forgiveness numerous times, highlighting its significance in his teachings.

While It's hard to pin down an exact number of times Jesus mentioned forgiveness, as his teachings permeate with the concept in various forms, direct references and parables collectively point to forgiveness over 30 times.

<u>World Day of Prayer</u> was held locally on Saturday 1st March, attended by over 100 people from many of the local churches in the area, including a number of our own parishioners, some of whom were part of the organising team. Thanks go to Pat Nevin and Pat Fuchter for representing our parish in the day's planning. Preparations are already underway for the next World Day of Prayer, which will be devised by the group in Nigeria.

<u>Churches Together Lenten Lunch events</u> Just a reminder that we will host the <u>Churches Together Lenten Lunch at OLSE at 11.30am on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Guide the elect of your Church, strengthen them in their vocation, build them into the kingdom of your Son, and seal them with the Spirit of your promise."
