JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: FORGIVENESS

This is the last week this month looking at the second of the six Jubilee themes - Forgiveness.

From a reflection by Canon Jason James, Archdiocese of Cardiff
When we experience the forgiveness of God in our own lives and pass on that
forgiveness, we are celebrating the whole nature and purpose of this [Jubilee]
year to give hope to others as we receive Hope from God Himself.
We start our Lenten journey each year on Ash Wednesday when we are marked
with ash, the ash of the ground reminding us that God created Adam from the
ash and the dust of the earth - let us make man in our image - and so when we
forgive we make present that very image of God, who is love and mercy. But we
know like ash we can smudge that particular manifestation of God's forgiveness
by our sins, our weaknesses and our shortcomings. But the Jubilee of
forgiveness that we celebrate this holy year is a wonderful chance for us to
make present once again this gift of forgiveness. We have the wonderful
example of the prodigal father who can help us to refashion ourselves, to
recreate ourselves, so as to make present this all-embracing unbounding
forgiveness of God to others around us.
