JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: FOOD POVERTY

In our weekly newsletters during this Jubilee Year of Hope we reflect on one of the six themes on which we are encouraged to focus. Throughout this month of June we are looking at Food Poverty, this week on local poverty.

Hunstanton's Foodbank steps in with emergency support when people run out of food and have no money. As more and more families fall into hardship, they also provide top-up funds for energy bills and High St food vouchers to cover school holidays. In 2024-25 two-thirds of the food parcels went to families with children. And the Foodbank gave extra support to around 150 families with £145 in food and energy vouchers plus school uniforms.

Too many people locally are trapped in poverty, some in poor health. Universal Credit does not cover the essentials and most local work is low-paid. In winter it can be "heat or eat". How can we help? <u>Pray</u> the Government takes urgent action. <u>Support</u> those in need by donations to the Foodbank or in other ways.

<u>Stand up for the dignity and rights</u> of our brothers and sisters in hardship.
