## JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: MANAGING DEBT

The sixth and final theme of the Jubilee Year of Hope is **Managing Debt** In the document outlining the vision for the Catholic Church's Jubilee year in 2025 titled 'Spes non confundit', or 'Hope does not disappoint' - Pope Francis called for an end to arms sales and renewed action to tackle poverty and hunger. The document called for Debt cancellation as a matter of 'justice, not generosity' observing that rich countries must cancel debts owed by lower-income countries because these countries are unable to repay debt: an "ecological debt" is owed by richer countries due to "the disproportionate use of natural resources by certain countries over long periods of time". If we really wish to prepare a path to peace in our world, let us commit ourselves to remedying the remote causes of injustice, settling unjust and unpayable debts, and feeding the hungry.
