# <u>JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: MANAGING DEBT What is CAFOD calling for on the debt crisis?</u>

Incredibly, almost 90% of debt contracts of the poorest countries are governed by English law due to the pivotal role of the City of London in the global financial sector. The UK ultimately oversees how these debts are enforced.

Currently, when a country is unable to meet repayments, it requests debt cancellation; other governments, and multilateral institutions like the World Bank and IMF, then work with that country to find a way forward. But private lenders insist on repayments no matter the human cost. The G20 group of countries have been ineffective. We need new legislation to ensure fair and equal treatment for lenders for more comprehensive reduction of countries' debts. As UK citizens, we can play a key role in pushing our government to pass this legislation by writing to our MP about a Debt Justice Law.

#### ADVENT APPROACHES

THE POSADA: Advent begins on Sunday 30th November, and with it the start of our parish POSADA - a Mexican tradition which recalls the journey of Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem and their search for a place to stay.

Our modern Posada uses a pilgrim statue of Mary, Joseph and the donkey which travels around the parish, giving everyone an opportunity to host it for the **night** and use it for their **Christmas preparation** as they recall the story and use it as a focus for prayer. Suggested prayers come on a prayer sheet with the Posada, and some people like to say the Rosary.

There is a sign up sheet in the porch for you to add your name to host the statue on a day that suits you. On the day the person before you on the rota will arrange to hand the statue over to you, and on the following day you hand it over to the next person on the list.
