JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: MANAGING DEBT Won't countries just get into debt crisis again if it's cancelled?

Not if we reform the system to stop the cycle of debt crises from happening. We need clear legislation and a permanent global debt mechanism to ensure that debts are agreed transparently and that there is a functional relief and restructuring framework.

This will incentivise lenders to be more responsible with their loans, taking greater care over whether they can be repaid. A transparent register of loans would also help hold governments and lenders to account, and so make problem debts less likely to arise.

Beyond this, we need to tackle other underlying causes of lower income countries being so dependent on debt in the first place, such as tax avoidance and evasion, unfair trade rules, and the climate emergency.

ADVENT APPROACHES

THE POSADA: Advent begins on <u>Sunday 30th November</u>, and with it the start of our parish <u>POSADA</u> - a Mexican tradition which recalls the journey of Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem and their search for a place to stay.

Our modern Posada uses a pilgrim statue of Mary, Joseph and the donkey which travels around the parish, giving everyone an opportunity to host it for the night and use it for their Christmas preparation as they recall the story and use it as a focus for prayer. Suggested prayers come on a prayer sheet with the Posada, and some people like to say the Rosary.

There is <u>a sign up sheet in the porch</u> for you to add your name to host the statue on a day that suits you. On the day the person before you on the rota will arrange to hand the statue over to you, and on the following day you hand it over to the next person on the list.

In previous years, people have much enjoyed hosting the statue so do sign up for it if you can. You will be glad you did!
