JUBILEE 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE - Jubilee themes: FOOD POVERTY In the final month of this Jubilee Year of Hope, we look again at Food Poverty, both local and global.

On the first World Food Day of his papacy, Pope Leo decried the fact that while humanity has made huge advances in technology, medicine, agriculture and transportation, 673 million people go to bed hungry each night, and 2.3 billion people cannot afford a healthy diet. The FAO statistics are not just numbers, he said: "behind each of these numbers is a broken life, a vulnerable community." While governments have an obvious role in addressing hunger, Pope Leo said no one can consider the problem to be someone else's responsibility. "How can we explain the inequalities that allow a few to have everything, while so many have nothing?" Pope Leo asked. During Advent, we'll be taking this to heart (see over).
