SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD This Third Sunday in Ordinary Time marks the seventh Sunday of the Word of God, which was instituted by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter *Aperuit illis* ("He opened to them"). The **Sunday of the Word of God** is a profoundly pastoral initiative to make it clear how important it is in the daily life of the Church and our communities to refer to the Word of God, a Word that is not confined to a book, but which remains ever alive and becomes a concrete and tangible sign.

The biblical expression chosen for the celebration of the seventh edition of the Sunday of the Word of God is taken from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Colossians: "**The word of Christ dwells among you**" (3:16). Support Needed for Families in Kyiv: Several families from our Catholic community in Kyiv have reached out asking for help during this extremely difficult time. Ongoing blackouts mean that many people have electricity for only a few hours a day, and some are without power for more than 20 hours at a time. With temperatures dropping to -15°C, the situation is especially dangerous for children, the elderly, and the sick.

There is an urgent need for power stations and power banks, which can provide light, warmth, to cook food and the ability to stay connected during long outages. Donations will also help us purchase other life-necessary goods for families struggling to survive these harsh conditions amid the war.

Not because he offers technical solutions, but because his life points to the authentic source of peace.*"
