**Pope Leo XIV's first Encyclical has now been published**

**Magnifica Humanitas**

The Encyclical of Pope Leo XIV on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence

Pope Leo XIV, in presenting to the world and to all the people of God, his first Encyclical Letter, focused on the care for the human person in the time of Artificial Intelligence, said "I invite all members of the Church and of the human family: let us learn to listen to one another, face the present challenges with courage, and cooperate in building a more human and fraternal society. [...] Please take with you a commitment to stay awake and, as 'artisans of hope', to keep on building the worksite of our time. May the Spirit of the Risen Lord Jesus sustain our work together."

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2027:** Enrolment is now open for the first Holy Communion class for Eastertide next year. **First Holy Communions will be on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2027, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Easter**, and the course of formation will commence early in the new school year in September 2026. Children who will begin Year 3 this September, or who are older but have not yet been prepared for first Holy Communion are eligible. Enrolment is open until Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July when the schools break up for summer; any children from our parish who wish to join the class will be very welcome. Classes, each an hour long, take place on approx. 11 Saturday mornings at 11am in Holy Family Church in King's Lynn.
