HISTORIC CHASUBLE ON DISPLAY In recent weeks, **a late 19th Century Roman, or Fiddleback chasuble** which was discovered in the attic of the Presbytery in very poor and fragile condition, **has been mounted and displayed in the Garnett room.** It was necessary to separate the front of the vestment from the back and to use the best of the silk from the front to repair the extensive damage to the back. The chasuble would have been used first by Father Garnett during funerals.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION AT OXBURGH HALL. The annual Corpus Christi Procession will take place starting at 3pm today, 7th June. Tickets are needed to get into the Hall grounds; these are available at church. It's a beautiful and reverent occasion, if you can make it.

JUBILEE MASS The 50 year Jubilee of the Diocese of East Anglia will be celebrated with a special **Mass at the Cathedral on 26th June at midday.** Each parish has been offered a set number of tickets. FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2027: Enrolment is now open for the first Holy Communion class for Eastertide next year. **First Holy Communions will be on Sunday 11th April 2027, the 3rd Sunday of Easter,** and the course of formation will commence early in the new school year in September 2026. Children who will begin Year 3 this September, or who are older but have not yet been prepared for first Holy Communion are eligible. Enrolment is open until Sunday 19th July when the schools break up for summer; any children from our parish who wish to join the class will be very welcome. Classes, each an hour long, take place on approx. 11 Saturday mornings at 11am in Holy Family Church in King's Lynn.
