A message from Bishop Peter

“This Sunday, 21 June, we mark the Day for Life under the theme “The Wonder of the Child in the Womb.” The theme also recognises the loss of children who died before birth and the grief of their parents. The bishops’ message and prayers can be found on the Day for Life website: www.dayforlife.org. The second collection will go towards the Day for Life Fund, which distributes grants to organisations that promote respect for life from conception until natural death. You can also donate online via the Day for Life website.”

At the other end of life, recent news reports that the Assisted Dying Bill will be brought back to the House of Commons, in exactly the same form as before. This is despite consistent polls that show that a majority of the public are now against it. Our prayers are needed once again on this Day for Life for a change of hearts and minds.

MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS: Pope Leo's first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas*, is now available for parishioners to read. There is one copy at each church. If you would like to borrow it, just write your name on the list when you borrow it, and on the inside cover of the booklet before returning.

PATRONAL FEAST: This year will be celebrating **our Patronal Feast of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour** with a **special Mass at OLSE at 10:30 on Saturday 27th** . We hope to see as many parishioners as possible from both churches for this special feast, as which we will pray especially for **the Homeless, the Poor and the Oppressed.**

There will be refreshments (including a glass of something to toast Our Lady) in the Garnett Room afterwards.

ADVANCE NOTICE: CYCLE OF PRAYER: Each parish in the Diocese is allocated a week in the year during which to pray for the Intentions of the National Cycle of Prayer and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. We have been allocated the week of 19th July. As with last year, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after each Mass during that week. More information later.

PARISH SUMMER PICNIC: Following on from the success of this year's Strawberry Fayre at St Cecilia, everyone is invited to join us for the Parish Summer Picnic at OLSE. We had previously called this an International lunch, but think perhaps this caused some confusion! So, we are proposing a summer picnic lunch in the grounds of OLSE on Saturday 1 August (12:00 to 3:00)

We are hoping that enough people will be prepared to contribute a dish (of an international flavour or not!) to share with others to form a picnic buffet for everyone. As with the parish BBQ in previous years, drinks (including beer and wine) will be provided by the parish and attendance at the event will be free! Because we are planning to provide food and drink, we need to get an early feel for numbers, so if **you would like to attend please add your name to the list** (there is one at each church). Posters will also go up soon. Please note as we have said in previous Newsletters, this will only take place if enough people are interested in attending such an event, so please add your name to the list as soon as possible and **by 13 July at latest.**"

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2027: Enrolment is now open for the first Holy Communion class for Eastertide next year. **First Holy Communions will be on Sunday 11th April 2027, the 3rd Sunday of Easter**, and the course of formation will commence early in the new school year in September 2026. Children who will begin Year 3 this September, or who are older but have not yet been prepared for first Holy Communion are eligible. **Enrolment is open 'til Sunday 19th July** when the schools break up for summer; any children from our parish who wish to join the class will be very welcome. Classes, each an hour long, take place on approx. 11 Saturday mornings at 11am in Holy Family Church in King's Lynn.
