**NATIONAL CYCLE OF PRAYER part 1**

The **Cycle of Prayer** seeks to preserve the integrity of the Sunday liturgy, without losing sight of the importance of being united with the universal or local Church in praying and working for important intentions. It seeks to do this by encouraging the faithful to pray for the intentions set out in the Cycle in their personal prayers throughout the period specified, and not only at Mass on a particular day.

The Cycle of Prayer is based on a division of the year into six periods, three of these being the principal liturgical seasons of Advent/Christmas; Lent and Easter and the other three periods being divisions of Ordinary Time, namely Winter, Summer and Autumn.

Each of these six periods is allocated its proper series of intentions for prayer, which may be taken up by both individuals and parishes and other groups throughout the season.

We are now in the summer part of Ordinary Time, with its own series of special intentions, which we will look at next week.

Consequently, the Steering Group is no longer needed. There will be more information about this in due course.

REPOSITORY WORKS: Angela would like to thank all the parishioners for their wonderful support of the Repository stall at Our Lady's. It has enabled her to give Natalia £200 already this year to send to the orphans in Ukraine.

CYCLE OF PRAYER: Each parish in the Diocese is allocated a week in the year during which to pray for the Intentions of the National Cycle of Prayer and for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. We have been allocated the week of 19<sup>th</sup> July. As with last year, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after each Mass during that week.

MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS: It's uplifting to note that both of the two copies of Pope Leo's first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas*, now available for parishioners to read, have been borrowed. The encyclical is described as offering "a path out of our anxious, brittle social life and into the peace and flourishing we yearn for" (Anna Rowlands, British theologian and member of the Vatican's Dicastery for Integral Human Development). FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2027: Enrolment is now open for the first Holy Communion class for Eastertide next year. **First Holy Communions will be on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2027, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Easter**, and the course of formation will commence early in the new school year in September 2026. Children who will begin Year 3 this September, or who are older but have not yet been prepared for first Holy Communion are eligible. **Enrolment is open 'til Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July** when the schools break up for summer; any children from our parish who wish to join the class will be very welcome. Classes, each an hour long, take place on approx. 11 Saturday mornings at 11am in Holy Family Church in King's Lynn.
